Country Markets are a nation wide organization, working like a co-operative and started trading in 1919 in Lewes, Sussex, under the name of 'The W.I. Market,' (The Women's Institute). We are a non profit organization.

It has come a long way since then with a change of name, about 10 years ago, to "Country Markets".(the W.I. being a charity and the Markets, a business)

The Street Branch started in 1977, 40 years ago this year, and up until this year traded out of the Crispin Hall. It now has a new home in the United Reformed Church allowing the Crispin Hall to be refurbished.

Our principles, are ,- Home Grown, Home Made and Home Crafted, making each market "local" , cutting down on road miles and even air miles.

We have a Facebook page giving information and photos on products and produce coming in.

The Market is open every Thursday from 9 .00 a.m. till 12.00 noon only closing for the first 3 weeks after Christmas, and an occasional week when we clash with other local events.

Orders can be placed for anything there and for special items on any of our stalls.

Now the kitchen is finished we will be serving refreshments throughout the morning, a place to sit, have a drink, sample any of our produce, have a chat, browse the various products that come in that week.

We will be celebrating our 40 years later on, a big mile stone for a small business in the heart of Street and then in two years time, the 100 years of the organization.
