

**Somerset County Council**  
**High Street and Leigh Road, Street**  
**Temporary Road Closure, Temporary Lane Closure and**  
**Temporary One Way Order 2020**

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after communicating with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

This Order will come into operation on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of April 2020 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The effect of which will be to introduce a Temporary Road Closure, Temporary Lane Closure and enforce a Temporary One Way Order in the roads specified in the Schedules to this Order. The restrictions will apply when indicated by traffic signs.

The gas mains upgrade works are expected to start on the **24<sup>th</sup> day of April 2020** for a period of **6 days** (24 hours).

**Temporary One Way Order**

Leigh Road, Street	For its entire length in a north-westerly direction
