PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF STOPPING, WAITING, LOADING AND
UNLOADING, AND ON-STREET PARKING
MENDIP ORDER 2012
(AMENDMENT NO. 21) ORDER 2022

Notice is hereby given that the Somerset County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') as amended; and the Traffic Management Act 2004, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 2004') as amended, and all other enabling powers.

The effect will result in changes to the parking and waiting restrictions in the following location:

Glastonbury: Wellhouse Lane, Wells Road, Merrick Road, Hamlyn Road, Leg of Mutton Road, Northload Street, Paradise Road, Garvins Road, Benedict Street, Chilkwell Street, Bretenoux Road

Street: Middle Brooks, Westway, West Leaze (Queen Elizabeth Court), Willow Road, Goss Drive, Silver Road, Leigh Road, Portway, Housman Road

Walton: Meadow Lane

Frome: The Butts, Cork Street, Portway Gardens

Rode: Rode Hill, High Street

West Pennard: Newtown Lane

Wells: Ash Lane, Kennion Road

Nunney: Glebelands
